



## MARDEN'S CLUB

### NOTES ACCOMPANYING THE RACE ENTRY FORM

All races held by the Club shall as far as is practical determined by the Committee be held in accordance with the British Ski Racing Rules.

**Helmets are compulsory** for all competitors taking part in any Marden's race (with the exception of the marathon and fancy dress roped slalom, where they are strongly advised).

While most Marden's races are run down designated race pistes and set by Davos Klosters Mountains or qualified instructor from the ski school, some events (such as the Marathon) are run on the open pistes. In such events all competitors must comply with the 10 FIS Rules for Conduct. These are highlighted at the tops and bottoms of many of the lifts and are also available on request.

I understand that photographs of the race might appear in the Club Review, Club website and the Klosters local press. Wherever possible the names of junior racers will not be used except with the consent of the parent/guardian of the racer.

**All participants must have appropriate winter sports insurance, which must include amateur racing.** If you are unsure whether your policy includes this then you should get in touch with your broker and should not race until the situation has been clarified. Additionally, you may be interested to know that MPI Brokers specialise in winter sports insurance and their policies include cover for amateur non international racing (and off piste skiing with no exclusion or limitation). **I understand that I am responsible for ensuring that I (or my child/children) have appropriate winter sports insurance.**

*Skiing involves an element of risk which all participants must accept as inherent in the sport. Accordingly you must take responsibility over your own actions and decisions, particularly with regard to speed, choice of route and overtaking when skiing on the mountain. It is known that accidents do happen as a part of skiing and by joining a Marden's race you will be accepting the risk involved.*

I understand that Marden's Club, and their appointed representatives, are not responsible or liable for any accidents or injuries incurred to participants and/or any other third parties during the course of a Marden's race.
